POLICY: As an Assisted Living with Dementia Care licensed facility, Atlas Villas Memory Care supports person-centered and evidence-based evaluation of behavioral symptoms and design of supports for intervention plans; including nonpharmacological interventions or practices in the following ways:

Encourage fluids and offer snack/food
Encourage individual time to rest
Encourage participation in life enrichment activities
Encourage family engagement
Environmental adjustments
Structured routine
Therapeutic communication
Sensory stimulation as appropriate
Others as appropriate based on resident preference and individual need

PROCEDURE:

1. Atlas Villas Memory Care will identify behavioral symptoms that negatively impact other residents and others in the assisted living facility and evaluate to determine potential interventions to minimize such behaviors.
2. Interventions will be identified on the care plan or service plan.
3. Behavioral symptoms that require outside consultation or acute care placement will be identified and acted upon.
